Detailed description

Separate tack and clew lines for each set of reefing lines. Two sets of reefing lines = 4 lines.

Tape over nuts and, once loosened, tape over screws to prevent loss.

Mark location of each block on base of mast.

Removing caulking around hole in deck at base of mast is a bit tricky. Care must be exercised to avoid damage to wires. 4 Wires: 1) Anemometer; 2) VHF co-ax antenna lead; 3) 14-2 AWG Anchor light; 12-3 AWG for Foredeck and steaming light Remove overhead panels and disconnect leads from Anemometer, VHF, anchor light and foredeck/steaming light. Note color coding of Anemometer leads. Remove compression connection for PL-259 VHF connector.

Folding mainsail is a two person job.

Coil genoa sheets and store with sail. Carefully store luff feeder from ProFurl. Coil staysail sheets and store with sail.
